CAMFT-CSJVC is offering two, \$500 scholarships to pre-licensed individuals pursuing graduate study or licensure as a Marriage and Family Therapist in the Central Valley region. These scholarships are aimed at assisting pre-licensed individuals in pursuing their graduate education and/or participation in continuing education and training.

Scholarship funds are awarded at the discretion of the CAMFT-CSJVC Scholarship Committee and may be used towards tuition, fees, continuing education costs, training or anything the recipient identifies that advances their skills and training within the MFT profession. Only complete application will be considered; partial applications or those missing requirements will not be considered for this award. Recipients will be notified prior to the annual membership luncheon and are encouraged to attend this event to be formally presented their award.


These scholarships are designed for pre-licensed members, belonging to both the state and local CAMFT organizations, who are:

- Pursuing an advanced degree beyond the qualifying degree for license.
- Participating in advanced training, education or an unpaid internship within the field of marriage and family therapy (degree-seeking candidates must be enrolled in a qualifying degree program as defined by the BBS).
- Seeking additional training to further their skills, knowledge and abilities within the MFT field.


